



## Glazing Contractors Association of BC Awards

GCABC recognizes the hard work that each individual member, company, and industry leader plays in helping our industry and trade grow. We want to showcase the hard work each of you put into your work. We want to honour those individuals and companies that have gone above and beyond.

### Award Categories

1. GCABC Member of the Year (*Company*)
2. Project Excellence Award (*Company*)
3. Outstanding Individual Award (*Individual*)
4. Community Contribution Award (*Company or Individual*)
5. GCABC Volunteer of the Year (*Individual*)

### General Rules

- Projects must be completed by September of the every year.
- You may nominate a company or individual or you can submit a self-nomination
- Applicants must either be a employee of or a company that is a member in good standing.
- You may enter more than one category but can only submit one nomination per category.
- Entry must be typed: maximum of three pages, 300 – 1000 words
- Photos, brochures, and press clippings may be included as supporting documents to your submission
- Completed entry form with your submission.
- No entry fee for submissions.
- All entries must be received no later than October 15<sup>th</sup> of every year.

### Judging

Judges will be selected from the GCABC Alumni and/or Board members. Top three finalists will be outlined in the following issue of the Cutting Edge Enewsletter and in Glass Canada magazine. Submissions will be judged on content and not appearance. Judges may follow up with applicants for clarification purposes at their discretion. **One winner per category, although not all categories may be awarded in any given year.** Decision of the judges are final.

## Categories and Application Guidelines

### **GCABC Member of the Year**

The purpose of this award is to recognize the service of a GCABC member company. It is awarded for the company's significant contribution to the GCABC through participation in and support of its committees, events, meetings, member recruitment, or other significant activities.

**Criteria:** Company must be a member in good standing for a minimum of two years. The company must have a representative on one of the GCABC's committees. The recipient must be present at the Awards Gala.

### **Project Excellence Award**

The purpose of this award is to recognize projects that have demonstrated design and/or construction excellence, energy efficient buildings, or new uses of technology. It is not intended that the project size (financial or dimensional) be a significant criteria for selection of the award winner. The governing criteria for award selection should emphasize design excellence and innovation as well as innovative techniques for the project. Team submissions are encouraged.

**Criteria:** The company (or one company from the team) is based out of BC but the project can be anywhere in the world. The project must have been completed by September. The application should outline the reason why the project is both unique and innovative. The recipient or representative from the team must be present at the Awards Gala.

### **Outstanding Individual Award**

The purpose of this award is to recognize an individual that has shown leadership and noteworthy achievement in their community and have demonstrated professional contributions to the glazing industry. This individual could also be someone who has battled back through troubled times to continue doing their job or creating opportunities for others.

**Criteria:** The individual must be a BC resident for at least five years. Their contribution and leadership should be recognizable in the glazing industry. The recipient must be present at the Awards Gala.

### **Community Contribution Award**

The purpose of this award is to recognize a company or individual who has given back to the community. Whether it's financial or time volunteered.

**Criteria:** The individual or company must be from British Columbia. The time and commitment must have taken place over the last three years. The company must be involved in the glazing trade in BC. The recipient must be present at the Awards Gala.

### **GCABC Volunteer of the Year**

The purpose of this award is to recognize an individual that has provided extraordinary service and who has contributed their time to the Glazing Association. It is awarded for the individual's significant contribution to the GCABC through participation in and support of its committees, events, meetings, member recruitment, or other activities.

**Criteria:** The individual must be employed by a GCABC member company in good standing. He/she should have served on a committee for a minimum of one year. The individual must be present at the Awards Gala.
