

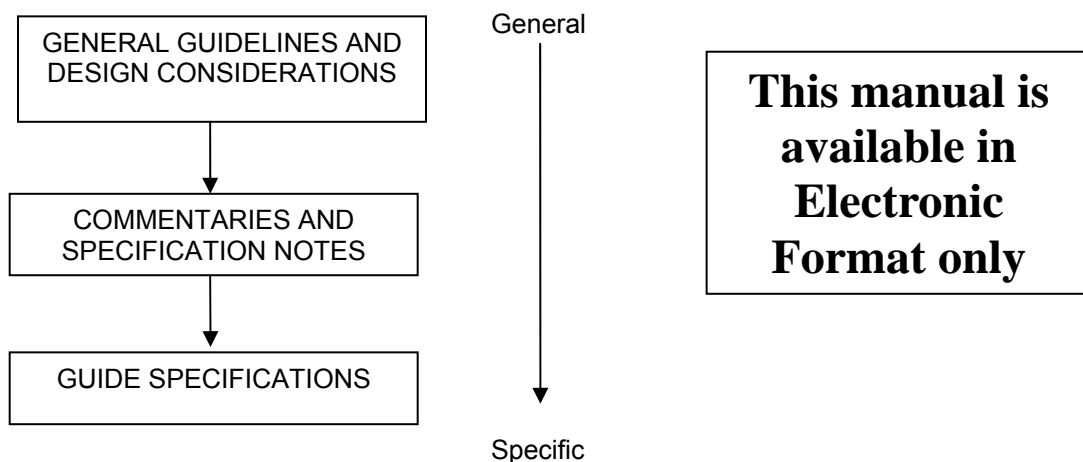


The New National Version of the Glazing Systems Specifications Manual
